4. Appropriate hygiene measures will be implemented to prevent the spread of dieback and weed seeds
5. Pedestrian safety will be considered
6. Possession of, or being under the influence of, alcohol or illegal drugs or drugs that affect the ability to drive a vehicle is prohibited. Where taking prescribed medication, I will see advice from the doctor to ensure that the medication will not affect my ability to perform my duties.
7. Any vehicle used for volunteer activities must be subject to an appropriate pre-operation safety check.
 - a) Check all fluid levels: Oil, water, brake, power steering and fuel. Check tyre pressure regularly including spare tyre. Refer to Vehicle Manufacturer's specifications. Check operation of brakes; Foot and Park/Hand. Any item that could become a missile in the event of an accident, i.e. laptops, briefcase, luggage etc. should be carried in the boot.
 - b) Stocked and in-date First Aid Kit on board and easily accessible
8. I will liaise with the City's Environment Officer regarding all Bushcare activities and any issues arising relating to activities undertaken.
