

Historic Site plaques – suggestions for locations of historic significance

The City of Armadale is inviting community members to nominate local sites of historic significance on which to install commemorative plaques.

The City has committed to a series of plaques including:

- Heritage plaques placed on public and private buildings listed in the City's Municipal Heritage Inventory (green plaques),
- Memorial plaques placed in formally named parks and reserves that hold historic significance related to the person or group the park/reserve is named after (maroon red plaques), and
- Historic site plaques for locations within the City deemed worthy of a plaque which don't qualify for memorial or heritage plaques (blue plaques). These plaques are for sites, not buildings. There may not be any remaining infrastructure in place related to the historical significance of the site.
- The Armadale to Fremantle Railway sidings have been recognized with a separate series of black plaques as a single project.

Community members are invited to nominate sites that they believe are of historic significance to the City for consideration of a plaque. If you wish to nominate a site simply complete the form below providing as much detail as you can. If you wish to nominate a site but don't have the requested information, assistance in completing these details is available from the Birtwistle Local Studies Library.
