

What happens to my waste after the general waste bin is collected?

Residual waste from residents now goes to the Kwinana Energy Recovery plant, Australia's first of its kind. Instead of landfill, this waste is used to generate enough electricity for 55,000 homes in the region. Reducing landfill lowers greenhouse gas emissions, and by-products from the process are used in materials like road sub-base and building blocks.

Roleystone Green Waste Facility

The Roleystone Green Waste Facility is open from 8am to 4.45pm and is trialling being open on more weekends in 2025. All residents are eligible to dispose green waste at Roleystone Green Waste Facility, located at Springdale Road, Roleystone.

Note: Residential quantities only. Fees and charges apply. Evidence of City of Armadale residency is required. Mulch is not available from the Roleystone Green Waste Facility due to the risk of Polyphagous Shot-Hole Borer (PSHB).



Green waste verge collections

WHAT WILL BE COLLECTED

Tree and shrub prunings up to:

- 1.5 metres in length.
- 150mm (6 inches) in diameter.
- 4.5 cubic metres (approx. 3 trailer loads).

Green waste can be placed on the verge up to 2 days prior to the collection start date. Scan the QR code to view your green waste verge collection dates for 2025.





WARNING - In the event of a Total Fire Ban collections may be suspended until the all clear is given.

WHAT WILL NOT BE COLLECTED

- Boxes or bags of leaves or grass clippings.
- X Dug out lawn, sand or soil.
- K Long branches (over 1.5m).
- Garden chemicals, garden pots or reticulation.
- 🔀 General waste.
- X Sawn and treated timber.
- Green waste that is secured with ties, or placed near services, reticulation, walls or structures.
- Green waste on vacant land or public reserves.

Bulk waste verge collection

PLEASE DO

- Place waste neatly on your verge on the allocated weekend.
 - Allow 10 working days for collection.
- Keep checking your pile as it is your responsibility to ensure bulk waste remains tidy until collected.
- Secure bulk waste on your property if strong winds are forecast, or a severe weather warning is issued.

PLEASE DON'T

- Place your bulk waste on any other verge as it WILL NOT be collected from vacant land or public reserves.
- X Obstruct the footpath or the line of sight for pedestrians, cyclists and cars.
- X Exceed the allowed volume of bulk waste.
- > Place items near services, reticulation, walls, letterboxes or other structures.

WHAT WILL NOT BE COLLECTED

- X Glass, mirrors, or shower screens.
- X Tyres or motor vehicle parts.
- X TVs, computers and printers.
- 🗙 Mattresses.
- X Beanbags.
- All building materials, bricks, paving, tiles, toilet cisterns, concrete, wire, sand or cement.
- Asbestos or other fibrous cement products.
- X Garden or food waste.
- X Fire Extinguishers, EPIRBs or flares.
- Hazardous waste ie chemicals, oils, paint, pesticides, solvents, batteries, gas bottles or smoke detectors.
- X Items over 1.8 metres in length.
- X Unsorted bulk waste.

Items not collected must be removed within 48 hours. Look for a notice in your letterbox.

*Closed New Year's Day, Good Friday and Christmas Day. Closes at noon Christmas Eve and New Year's Eve. May be closed in extreme weather conditions.

Drop off recyclables and other materials: they do not belong in your kerbside bins.

Separate your load

RECYCLING free of charge

Glass bottles, steel and aluminium cans, clean flattened cardboard and polystyrene.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS free of charge (limits apply) WASTE

Gas bottles, paint, fluoro globes/tubes, batteries, motor oil, smoke detectors, electronic waste and household chemicals.

METAL WASTE free of charge

Scrap metal, white goods, fencing, sheet metal, car parts, bikes and lawnmowers.

GREEN WASTE

Tree and shrub prunings, stumps up to 300mm in diameter, grass clippings and leaves.

BUILDING WASTE

Timber, brick rubble, fibrous sheets and sand (must be separated).

SORTED WASTE

Broken items that cannot be reused, recycled or composted.



Up to 5kg of asbestos is accepted Mon to Sat between 8.30am and 12.30pm. Residents only. Strict acceptance guidelines must be followed.


